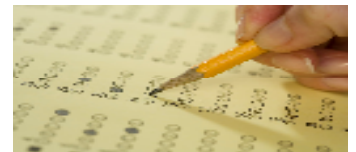
The Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare provides training course for foreign residents in Japan such as people of Japanese descent who are looking for a job in Japan, hoping that they will acquire Japanese ability and get a stable job.

## Target people:

- In principle, those who possess South American citizenship such as Brazilian, Peruvian, etc. and status of residence “spouse or child of Japanese(Nihonjin no Haigucha)”, “permanent resident(Eijyusha)”, “spouse or child of permanent resident(Eijyusha no haigusha)”, or “long term resident(Teijyusha)”.
- Those who want to get new work soon but find it difficult to get a stable job because they are lacking in Japanese language ability and skills concerning Japanese legislation, how to work in Japan, etc. or those who want to acquire such knowledge and skills
- Those who meet conditions as mentioned above and whose applications are registered at Hello Work

## Contents of training:

- Japanese language learning (acquiring Japanese language needed for job hunting activities in Japan and working in Japan)
- Lecture on Japanese way of working, how to undergo a job interview and how to write a resume
- Workplace visit etc.



★The period from December 23rd to January 4th is holiday. The class will be closed.

★ Level 3 is more advanced than level 1.

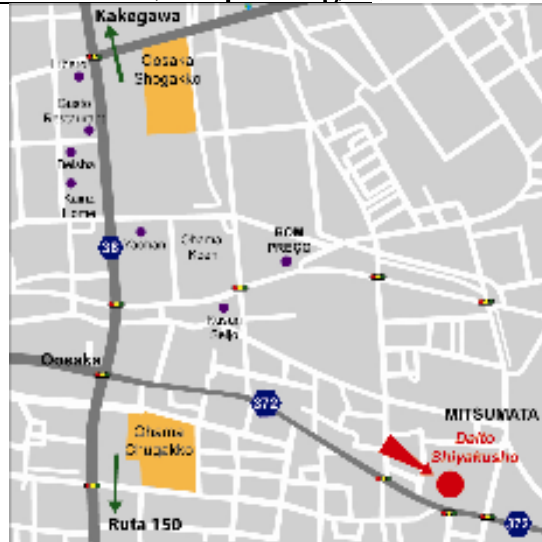
**Other:**

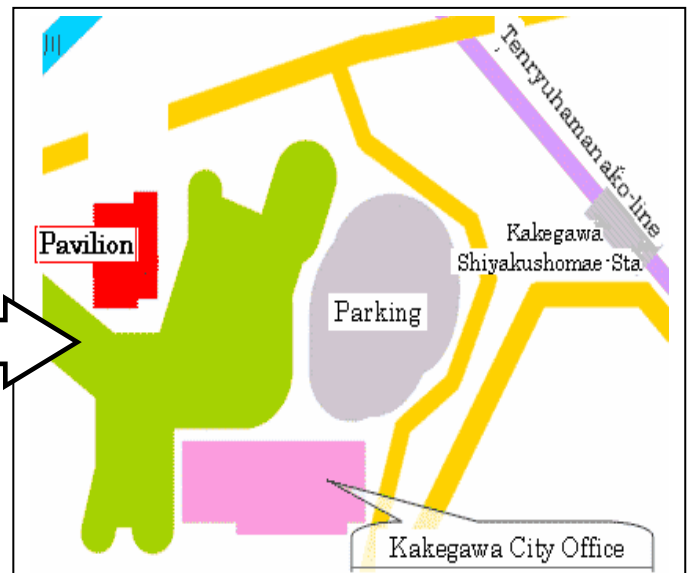
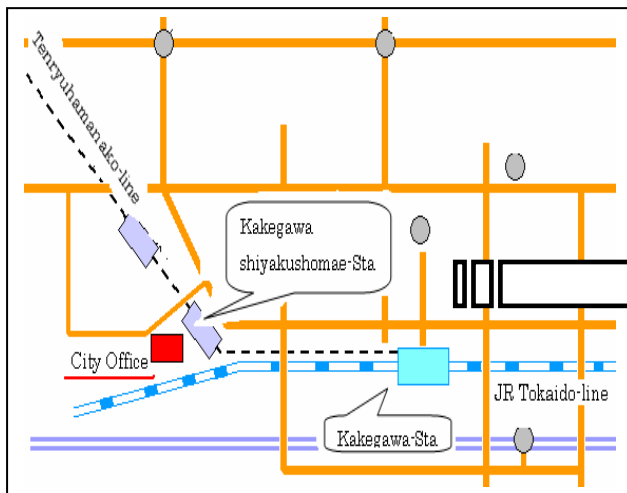
**Kakegawa City Office, Daito Branch (free parking)** (620 mitsumata, Kakegawa- City)
