

Training Course for Employment Preparation for People of Japanese Descent

Level 2 · Level 3 — Kakegawa and Kikugawa City, Shizuoka Prefecture

The Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare provides training courses on the Japanese language and finding employment to assist people of Japanese descent residing in Japan who are looking for work in Japan so that they can learn Japanese and find stable employment.

Eligible candidates:

- In principle, people who are citizens of South American countries such as Brazil and Peru and have residence status such as "spouse or child of Japanese (Nihonjin no haigusha)," "permanent resident (Eijyusha)," "spouse or child of permanent resident (Eijyusha no haigusha)" or "long-term resident (Teijyusha)."
- Those who want to get a new job quickly, but find it difficult to get a stable job due to a lack of knowledge about laws and/or work styles in Japan and a lack of the necessary skills, and wish to acquire such knowledge and skills.
- The person that Hello Work accepted an application.
- Those who attend the class without being absent.

Description of Training:

- Japanese classes (to learn the Japanese needed to find employment and work in Japan)
- Japanese work style, interview process, writing resumes
- Lectures on working environment and laws in Japan
- Tour of workplaces, etc.

Level 2 (**):

This course is for those who can read and write Hiragana/Katakana and have a little experience in studying Japanese. It is also available for those who can communicate with Japanese but are not good at speak politely.

Level 3 (***):

This course is for those who can read and write basic Kanji characters and have basic Japanese conversation skill. It is suitable for those who want to learn business conversation skill in Japanese language.

Fee: Free (however, participants are responsible for their transportation costs).

How to Apply:

- Consult Hello Work and follow the procedures (submit an application form).
- Please bring a photograph of yourself (3.0com×4.0cm) and ID card (resident card, alien registration card or passport) with you for your application.

Other: • The class may not be held if the number of participants does not reach 15.

Please study hiragana and katakana before the training begins.




- All participants are required to take the placement test to determine Japanese level.

Map of location:


Biography Cycle Pavilion in Kakegawa City Office
